Marcos L. Rosa is a professor in the Department of Architectural Design at the Faculty of Architecture and Urbanism, Federal University of Rio de Janeiro (FAU-UFRJ). He is an architect and urban planner, graduated from FAU-USP, with a PhD in Architecture and Urban Studies from the Technical University of Munich, and postdoctoral research at FAU-USP (São Paulo) and ETSAM-UPM (Madrid). His research is situated within the architectural design field, in dialogue with the theory and history of architecture and urbanism. It focuses on the contemporary urban condition and the relationships between spatiality, social practices, and the production of the city. His investigation explores alternative imaginaries of the urban ground, particularly through collective housing and the urban infrastructural space, emphasizing community-mediated processes and spatial appropriation. He is co-editor of several books on collective housing and social practices and is a member of international research networks and the Kuratorium of IBA'27 Stuttgart.
